# Yellow Label Stopping

- The perfect solution for filling holes and cracks in timber
- Interior grade, ideal for furniture, doors, skirting and panelling
- One part, easy to use and heat proof
- Available in a wide range of natural wood colours
- May be used under most types of decorative finish

**BRUMMER** Yellow Label wood stopping has been used for over 70 years by wood craftsmen, and nearly all the leading furniture and joinery manufacturers, to fill holes, cracks and other blemishes in wood. Yellow Label is putty like in consistency and made using only the best quality pigments and binders.

May be applied with a palette or putty knife and left slightly proud of the surrounding wood and allowed to dry. Once hardened the filler should be lightly sanded before applying the required finish. In most instances one application is sufficient, but for deep holes or cracks it should be applied in layers, allowing each one to dry before applying the next.



Yellow Label may be used under most proprietary ranges of stains, paints, lacquers, varnishes and polishes, and will accept most types of fixings, nails and screws when fully hardened.

When using **BRUMMER** it is always advisable to try a sample patch first, either on an area which will not be seen or a piece of card or similar to determine the final appearance.

Shades of Yellow Label may be mixed with most stains and dyes to match more unusual wood colours.

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# Green Label Stopping

- The perfect solution for filling holes and cracks in timber
- Exterior grade, ideal for use on conservatories, window frames, doors and garden furniture
- One part, easy to use and waterproof
- Available in a wide range of natural wood colours
- Suitable for use on boats as it is impervious to sea water

**BRUMMER** Green Label wood stopping has been used for over 70 years by wood craftsmen, boat builders and garden furniture manufacturers and in more recent years by the conservatory and double glazing trade. Green Label is made using only the best quality pigments and binders.

May be applied with a palette or putty knife and left slightly proud of the surrounding wood and allowed to dry. Once hardened the filler should be lightly sanded before applying the required finish. In most instances one application is sufficient, but for deep holes or cracks it should be applied in layers, allowing each one to dry before applying the next.



Green label may be used under most proprietary ranges of stains, paints, lacquers, varnishes and polishes, and will accept most types of fixings, nails and screws when fully hardened. Green Label may also be used on stonework, plaster, concrete and metal guttering.

Because Green Label is waterproof it is not necessary to apply a protective finish unless desired to match surround

When using **BRUMMER** it is always advisable to try a sample patch first, either on an area which will not be seen or a piece of card or similar to determine the final appearance.

# Rub-in Grain Filler

- Primes, seals and fills in one complete application
- Brings out the beauty of the wood without blinding the grain
- Perfect for building up veneers prior to sanding
- A paler colour may be used to achieve a natural limed effect
- Available in the full range of **BRUMMER** colours

Rub-in Grain Filler is a unique powder filler, specially formulated to smooth out rough, uneven grain thus eliminating the need to sand. It may be used under most varnishes, lacquers etc. It can also be used for rough castings, fibreglass and smoothing rough edges to provide a smooth finish.

Rub-in Grain Filler is in powder form made from natural raw materials, and different shades may be mixed together to achieve a wide range of colours.



Usually applied with a soft clean cloth lightly dampened and using a circular polishing motion, worked over the wood. It must be allowed to dry before varnishing or polishing and it is necessary to paint or varnish the filler to provide a waterproof finish for exterior use.

For larger applications it is advisable to pre-mix the filler - 1 part water to 2 parts powder blended to a smooth consistency, then apply as before. Wipe off any surplus and avoid allowing dried filler to build up on the cloth as it may scratch fine surfaces. Available in 300g retail pots and larger containers for commercial use

# Two-Part Wood Filler

- Easy to use multi purpose filler
- Excellent adhesion to a variety of surfaces
- Suitable for interior and exterior use
- May be sanded, shaped, drilled and painted
- Available in White, Light Oak and Medium Mahogany

Two-Part Wood Filler is a multi purpose wood filler for both interior and exterior applications, which may be moulded and carved to repair and build up joints and corners. Ready to use once mixed, the filler sets hard within approximately 30 minutes, depending on the amount of catalyst used and external conditions.

Two- Part Wood Filler is ideal for use in larger, deeper repairs where it may be applied in layers to ensure adhesion to substrate and enable a smooth finish to be achieved.



Once mixed the Two-Part Wood Filler has a working time of approximately 10 minutes. It may be applied with spatula, palette knife or similar utensil, working the filler well into the area to be repaired. Fill slightly proud where necessary to allow for sanding or planing.

Once set the filled area may be primed, painted or coated to the desired finish. For a natural wood finish a stain may be applied.

The various original Filler colours may be combined together to achieve different shades although the mixing should be done prior to adding the catalyst to the paste.

# Flooring Filler

- Perfect for filling small holes and splits in flooring
- Ready mixed and easy to use
- May be stained, polished, varnished or painted
- Durable, smooth finish resists shrinking and cracking
- May be sanded, nailed or screwed when dry

Flooring Filler is specially formulated with a plasticiser so it is ideal for larger areas of woodwork such as flooring, panelling and shelving where a degree of flexibility is required.

Putty like in consistency it may be applied with a palette knife or similar utensil. Applied firmly to the area to be filled it should be left slightly proud and allowed to dry. Once fully set the surplus can be lightly sanded to give a smooth finish.

Deep holes and cracks should be filled in layers, allowing each one to dry fully before applying the next layer.



Flooring Filler sets firm to bare wood, nail heads, screws and plaster.

If required a stain can be added to the filler and mixed well before application to give the desired colour finish. It is always suggested that a sample area is tried first.

Available in pine, light oak, medium oak, medium mahogany, dark mahogany and teak.

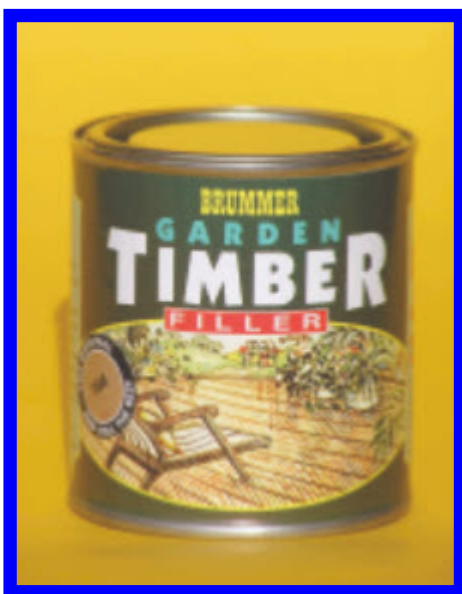
# Garden Timber Filler

**BRUMMER**

- Ideal for decking, garden furniture, window frames and conservatories
- Ready mixed, easy to use and may be treated to match surrounding timber
- Tough, durable finish, resists shrinking and cracking
- Available in a range of natural wood shades
- May be used under most types of decorative finish including paint, varnish and lacquer

Garden Timber Filler is formulated with a plasticiser so it is ideal for use on exterior timber where a greater degree of flexibility is required to accommodate the natural expansion and contraction of timber when exposed to the elements.

Putty like in consistency, applied firmly to the area to be filled with a palette knife or similar utensil it should be left slightly proud and allowed to dry. Once fully set the surplus can be lightly sanded to give a smooth finish.



Deep holes and cracks should be filled in layers, allowing each one to dry fully before applying the next. Garden Timber Filler adheres to bare timber, nail heads, screw etc.

If required a stain can be added to the filler and mixed before application to give the desired colour finish. Always try a sample area first.

Easily applied to bare wood, previously painted surfaces should be stripped prior to application. Finished surface should not be sanded.
