

Using Wood FILLER STICKS



- 1** *Ensure the area to be filled is clean and dry and free from any particles of dust or grease which may prevent the filler adhering properly. Brummer Tack Cloth is ideal for this. It is a dust absorbing cloth for use on any surface to give a clean, dust free finish.*
- 2** *To repair or fill in small scratches rub the Filler Stick across and along the scratch, then allow to harden and buff off the excess with a cloth.*
- 3** *For filling small holes such as woodworm holes - first cure the woodworm! Then shave a small piece off the Filler Stick and mould in the fingers to soften. Press into the hole firmly and then level off using the blade of a putty knife or similar utensil. Allow to harden and buff off the excess with a cloth.*
- 4** *When the filler is dry it may be painted with light strokes, using a fine artist's brush and a darker stain to give a wood grain effect and blend in with the surrounding surface. Then finish with a natural beeswax polish to match the patina of the surrounding wood.*
